FAST TRACK INTERNATIONAL FELLOWSHIP COURSE FOR LAWYERS

I wish to apply to attend the 2007 **Fast Track International Fellowship Course for Lawyers**. These Workshops are intended for suitably qualified candidates who are practicing lawyers of at least 10 years' standing and who otherwise have sufficient experience in arbitration. The two-day program consists of small discussion groups, in which candidates will be expected to demonstrate knowledge and skill in arbitration. Those candidates who then also pass the Award Writing examination (to be held 12 December 2007 at a cost of £335) and are subsequently interviewed to the satisfaction of the Council may apply for Fellowship (FCI Arb). Further steps can then be taken to become a 'Chartered Arbitrator.' **The Course syllabus is based on international arbitration law and it is essential that candidates have at least a reasonable working knowledge of UNCITRAL Model Law and Rules.**
